CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

OUTDOOR SKATING

Now that we have had consistently cold temperatures, the Town is working to build two outdoor skating rinks. One will be located at Mount Albert Community Centre Park and one at Ridgeview Park in Holland Landing. Once the rinks are complete we will share the news on social media. Please ensure you are following the safety signage posted.

The Town has also responded to residents skating on stormwater ponds throughout the Town. Please note, stormwater ponds are about three metres deep and don't behave like typical wetland ponds, especially in winter. No matter how long it's been cold or how deep into the winter, the ice on a stormwater pond is not strong and will not hold weight. The water below is unstable and constantly moving (which is a good thing because that movement prevents mosquitoes from breeding in the summer).

The Town urges residents to stay safe and off the ice.
