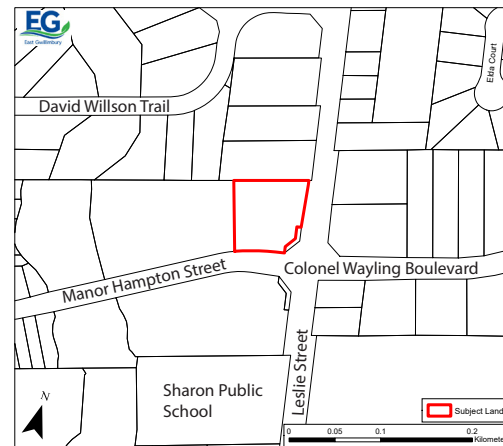

Mount Albert Water Supply Upgrades EA Study Update - York Region has issued a Notice of Completion for their Mount Albert Water Supply Upgrades Environmental Assessment. They are proposing to use a filtration system to remove magnesium and iron from the water which will address water aesthetic issues. The public can review the notice on their website until February 13. Following that, the Region will begin and testing a filtration system in 2021 and plan for the capital project budget and install.

Council Approved the 2021 Water Budget - The Town, in partnership with York Region, provides safe drinking water and treatment of wastewater for residents. At the January 19, 2021 Council meeting, Council approved the 2021 water/wastewater budget rates, which included no change from 2020. The rates are frozen for 2021 at:
