

VACCINE SUPPORT & INFORMATION

York Region is currently in phase 1 of its vaccine rollout plan, allowing residents that are 80+ (born in 1941 or before) and healthcare workers that are deemed highest or very high priority to book vaccination appointments.

COVID-19 BOOKING APPOINTMENT ASSISTANCE

Residents age 80+ who require assistance with booking an online appointment are encouraged to seek out a support person (caregiver, family member or friend) who can help booking an appointment on their behalf. The following methods are also available to assist with booking:

MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM

The Town's mosquito control program is scheduled to begin in April, weather permitting. The program consists of application of a biological larvicide (VectoBac 200G [PCP#18158, granular formulation]), by helicopter, to standing water mosquito breeding habitats within the Town.

Property owners within the treatment areas were mailed objection forms. If you object to having Vectobac applied to your property, please complete the objection form. No response is required if you support the mosquito control program.

A Statutory Public Meeting is being held on **Tuesday, March 23, 2021 at 6 p.m.** to consider a Draft Plan of Subdivision and Zoning By-law Amendment for 574 Green Lane East (File number 19T-20201 & ZBA.20.06), submitted by Malone Given Parsons Ltd.

PROPOSAL: To permit, one apartment building (6-storey), one stacked townhouse building (4-storey) and 10 townhouse units with a mixed use block containing one multi-tenant commercial building, one grocery store, one office building (4-storey) and one parking garage (4-storey). Future phases include, single detached dwellings and townhouses for a total of 260 units with a park and elementary school sites and a mixed use apartments block along Green Lane.

ONTARIO SMALL BUSINESS GRANT
