

VACCINE SUPPORT & INFORMATION

York Region continues to update vaccination eligibility as additional vaccines become available. Residents that are 70+ (born in 1951 or before) and high priority healthcare workers are now eligible for the vaccine.

MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM

The Town's mosquito control program is scheduled to begin in April, weather permitting. The program consists of application of a biological larvicide (VectoBac 200G [PCP#18158, granular formulation]), by helicopter, to standing water mosquito breeding habitats within the Town.

Property owners within the treatment areas were mailed objection forms. If you object to having Vectobac applied to your property, please complete the objection form. No response is required if you support the mosquito control program.
