

NOTICE OF WORK

CONTRACT No. T-20-12, MISCELLANEOUS CONCRETE REHABILITATION

Sidewalk bay and/or curb replacement work throughout Town will commence in the month of June, 2021 and are anticipated to last until late fall. Works are expected to take place in front of or near your property and take approximately one week per location, weather permitting.

All reasonable measures will be taken to ensure a non-intrusive construction process, however, in cases where private infrastructure is installed on Town property without consent, damages may occur as a result of construction and it will be the responsibility of the property owner to repair. This may include items such as sprinklers, invisible fences, private wiring, etc.

During the project, we will make a concerted effort to maintain access to your driveway; however, driveway access may be interrupted at times due to the formwork required for pouring new sidewalk bays or curb, and asphalt patches (if required) on both sides of the repair. Please see the attached illustration for details of a typical repair.


To ensure an effective and efficient project, please ensure parked vehicles are not blocking access to identified locations. Should the sidewalk or curb replacements span across your entire driveway, the works will be phased to allow a vehicle width to get through, as a minimum.
