Key responsibilities include:

- Gain knowledge of the Ontario Building Code and Ontario Fire Code.
- Participate in the Smoke Alarm Program throughout the Town.
- Learn about fire investigations and assist in writing and preparing reports.
- Assist in public education programs, e.g. school visits, industry and company lectures.
- Participate in public education events, e.g. farmers markets, school presentations.
- Learn to recognize potential hazards in the workplace.
- Participate in giving tours of fire stations to various visitors and groups.
- Take an active part in training exercises e.g. catching hydrants, ropes and knots, etc.
- Basic knowledge of SCBA, fire pumps and basic hydraulics.
- Participate in non-emergency tasks e.g. hose rolling, vehicle and equipment maintenance.
- Other duties as assigned.
