Qualifications of Funding:

- 1. The application must be from a not-for-profit organization.
- 2. The applicant must complete the funding application outlining the program/service/expenditure and how it meets the needs of the East Gwillimbury community.
- 3. The applicant must provide documents to support the amount being requested (ie quote for supplies, materials, program delivery)
- 4. Priority will be given to: capital expenditures; program set up fees; one-time expenses.
- 5. Applications must be received by the set deadline of June 30 2023.

Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed and evaluated by the YCIF Application Review Team based on the following criteria:

- i. Contributions/benefit to the East Gwillimbury community
- ii. Other partners, other sources of funding, support of volunteers

Maximum Contribution:

No organization/agency will receive more than the maximum allowable grant of \$5,000

Please note:

- Only those organizations selected will be contacted.
- Applications are due by June 30, 2023.
- Decisions of the YCIF Application Review Team, consisting of Council appointed volunteers, will be considered final.
