PROJECT OVERVIEW

Project Objective

To replace and upgrade the aging watermain infrastructure

Project Scope

- **Watermain Replacement:**

- Charles Street – Mount Albert Rd to ~ 50m south of Morton Ave - 140m
- Morton Avenue – Charles Street to ~ 50m east of William St - 875m
- Howard Avenue – Mount Albert Rd to just south of Morton Ave - 120m
- William Street – Mount Albert Rd to just south of Morton Ave - 120m
- Mount Albert Road – Charles Street to ~50m east of William St – 875m

- **Restoration of all disturbed areas**

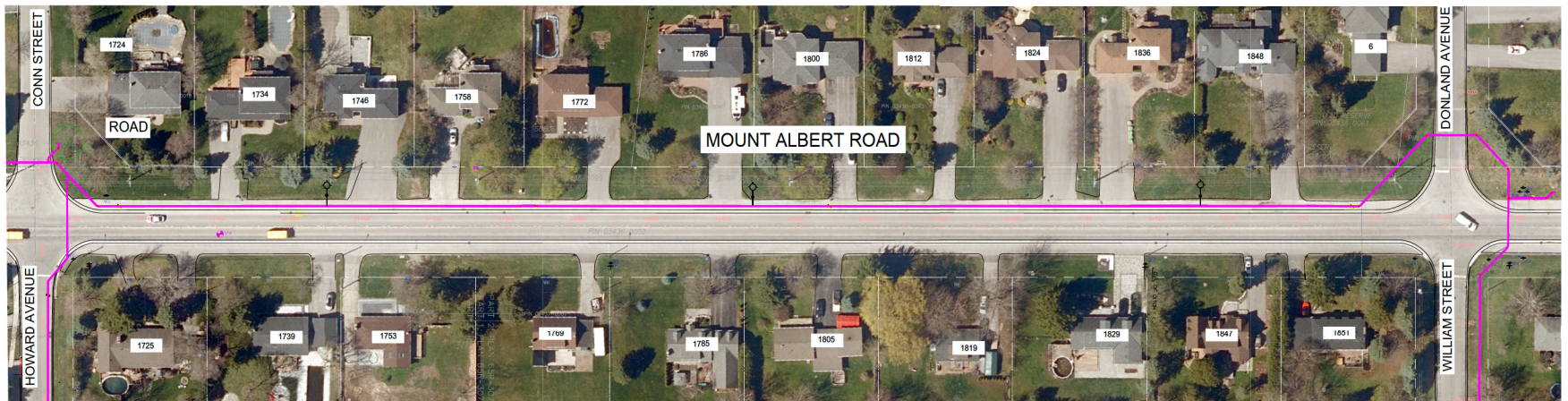
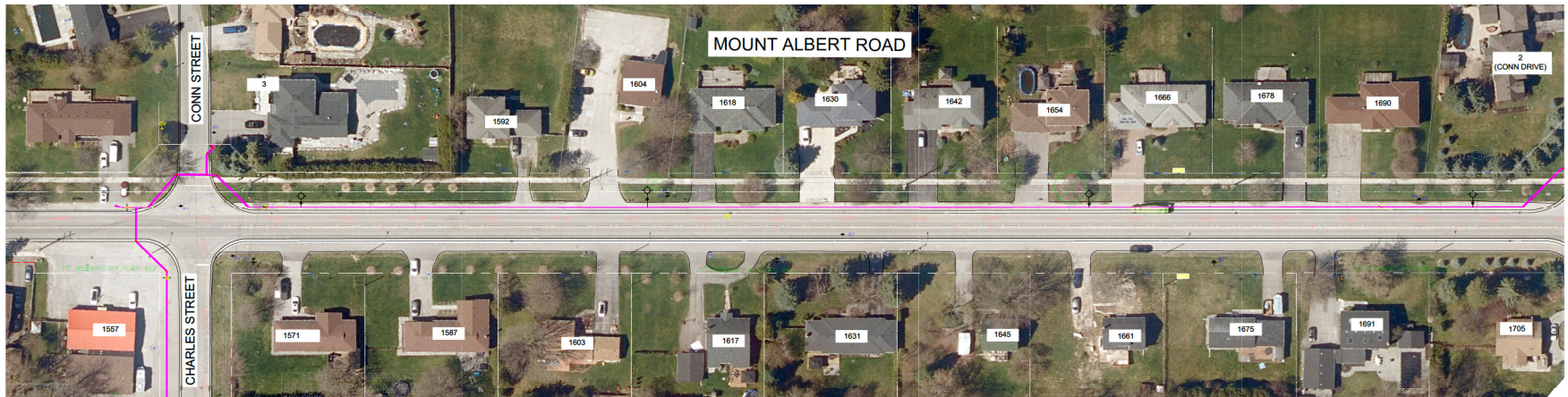
- Damaged sodded areas will be restored with new topsoil and sod. Impacted driveways to be restored with the same materials (gravel, asphalt, concrete)

- **Drainage Improvements on Morton Avenue**

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Pre- construction
 - Notice to be sent prior to construction commencing to identify sprinkler system locations.
- Communication
 - Progress updates and advanced notice will be provided for any temporary disruptions to water service and/or driveway access during construction.
- Driveway Access During Construction
 - Driveway access will be maintained for residents wherever possible. In the unlikely event temporary access is restricted, alternative walkway access and on-street parking will be provided.
- Measures will be in place to mitigate noise, dust, large equipment, truck traffic, and construction debris in the area.
- Construction signage and traffic control persons to guide residents
- Tree Impacts including branch trimming, root pruning, and removal of identified trees only if necessary. Residents will be informed in advance of any planned removals.
- Garbage, Recycling and Green Bin pick up schedules to be maintained.

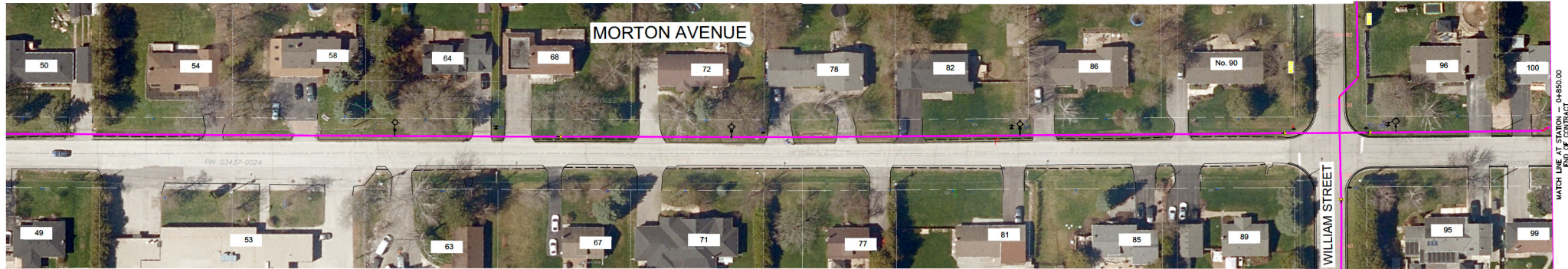
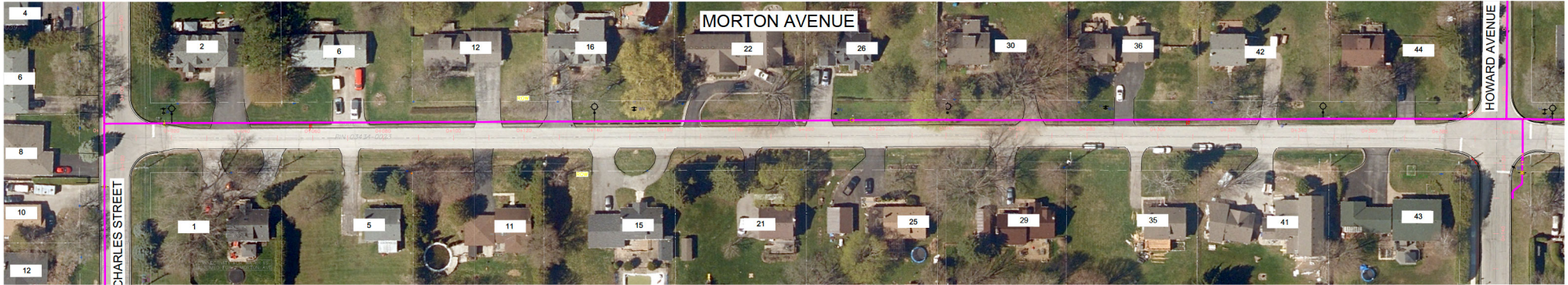
MOUNT ALBERT STREET

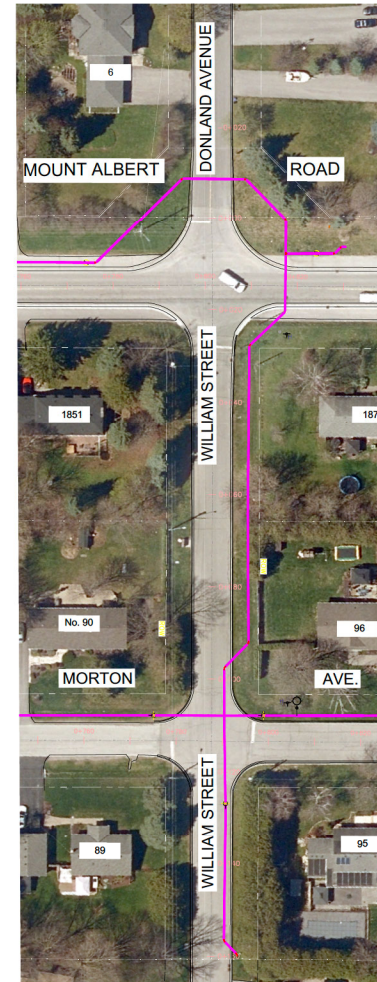
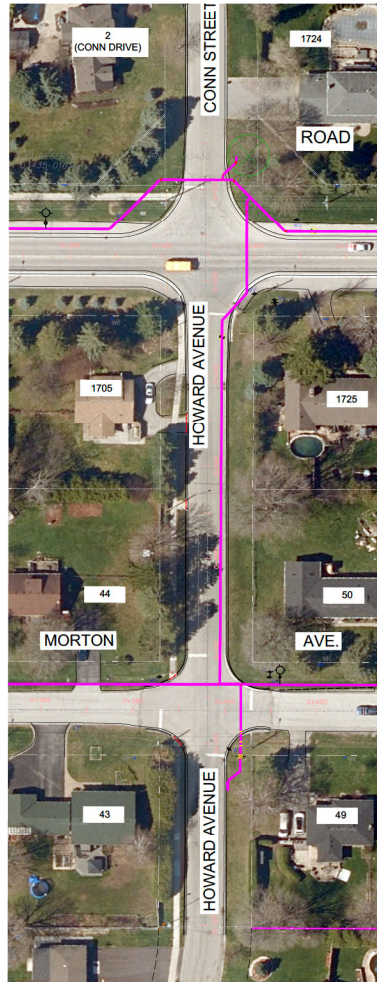
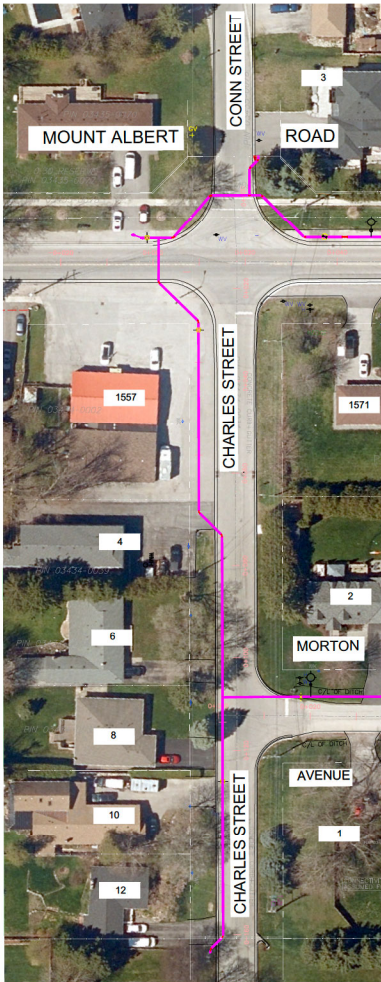
MORTON AVENUE
