

Mount Albert Downtown Revitalization Utility Investigations Notice

As part of the Mount Albert Downtown Revitalization utility designs, Planview Utility Services will be conducting utility investigations along the east side of Centre Street, on the asphalt boulevard. Utility investigations are scheduled to take place on April 23 and 24, weather permitting.

The utility investigations will include test holes excavated by a vacuum truck, in front of eight properties, and are expected to occur in the following order:

- 19101 Centre Street
- 19119 Centre Street
- 19127 Centre Street
- 19149 Centre Street
- 19153 Centre Street
- 19157 Centre Street
- 19169 Centre Street
- 19179 Centre Street

The road will remain open to traffic during this activity and each test hole is expected to take approximately one to three hours to complete and restore. Parking will be temporarily impacted while crews are onsite. As well, construction noise is anticipated while the vacuum truck excavations are underway.
