

2025 East Gwillimbury **Waste Calendar**





Important changes are coming to the Recycling Program. Effective December 31, 2025, the curbside recycling program will transition from a Town service to a provincial program. More details to come.



BLUE BOX RECYCLING REMINDERS

- Empty and rinse all food containers.
- Place recyclables loose in your blue box.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard boxes with twine/string. Maximum size 36 in. x 36 in. x 8 in.
- Use Town-approved blue boxes only. Blue boxes must not exceed 22 gallons (83 L) in capacity.
- ✓ DO NOT overfill your blue box.
- DO NOT use bins with attached lids or wheels for collection.
- DO NOT place recycling in bags. Bagged recycling is not accepted.





GREEN BIN ORGANICS REMINDERS

- Line your kitchen catcher or green bin with a certified compostable bag. Do not line both. Bag and tie securely.
- Remove plastic packaging and wrap from food before placing in your kitchen catcher or green bin.
- Accepted items include food waste, paper towels, pet waste and diapers.
- Use Town-approved green bins only. Green bins must not exceed 12 gallons (45 L) in capacity.
- Y DO NOT place items made of plastic, rubber, wax, wood, styrofoam or other garbage in the green bin.
- X DO NOT use a garbage bag in the areen bin.



GARBAGE REMINDERS

- Two-bag/container limit per collection day.
- Use garbage bag tags to place up to three additional garbage bags/ containers curbside.
- Large/oversized items (limit of four large items) are collected on your scheduled garbage collection day and require a large item tag.
- Garbage containers must be reusable, have open handles, a removable lid, and must not exceed 33 gallons (125 L) in capacity.
- Package broken glass separately in a labelled cardboard box.
- Toilets (with tank and bowl drained and separated) can be placed at the curb for collection as one item towards the two-bag limit.
- Renovation waste such as concrete, wood, and drywall is not accepted in the garbage or curbside. Visit York.ca/WasteDepots for disposal options.









LEAF AND YARD WASTE REMINDERS

- Place leaf and yard waste in kraft paper bags or garbage containers (no lids) with a 'yard waste' sticker.
- Bundle branches, sticks and twigs with twine. Bundles can be up to 4 ft. in length and 2 ft. in diameter Individual branches can be up to 4 in. in diameter.
- Containers/bundles must weigh less than 22 kg (50 lbs.).
- Yard waste in plastic bags, cardboard boxes, blue boxes, green bins or unmarked containers will not be collected.
- · Accepted materials include leaves, shrubbery, brush and tree trimmings, flowers, weeds, plants (soil removed), pumpkins, corn stalks and hay.
- Grass clippings, soil, sod, root balls and tree stumps are not accepted.



- Collection times can change without notice. Ensure material is at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.
- Do not place containers on top of or behind snowbanks, or on roadways or sidewalks.
- Large metal items such as appliances and BBQs require a special collection. Call GFL at 1-866-421-5625 to schedule a pickup.
- All garbage, green bin, and blue box containers must weigh less than 22 kg (50 lbs.).



CURBSIDE GIVEAWAY DAYS

Place gently used items labelled 'FREE' at the curb in front of your home for others to take between 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Please dispose of these items safely at a York Region waste depot. For a complete list of accepted items and depot locations, visit York.ca/HHW or call 1-866-665-6752.











































2025 Waste Calendar
