

Sharon Heritage Conservation District

In accordance with Section 41.1 (6)(b) of the *Ontario Heritage Act* a public meeting will be held to receive input on the Sharon Heritage Conservation District (HCD) on:

January 27, 2026, at 6 p.m. at the East Gwillimbury Civic Centre located at 19000 Leslie Street, Sharon, ON.

PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE

The Town of East Gwillimbury has initiated the process to designate a HCD under Section 41, Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act* for the historic community of Sharon. This process also involves the creation of a Sharon HCD Plan and by-law.

The first public information session was held in March 2023, to obtain feedback on the Sharon HCD Study. A second public information session was held on Thursday, February 15, 2024, to present the findings and recommendations of the study and to obtain feedback from the community. A third public information session was held on September 12, 2024, to obtain community input.

On July 23, 2024, Council adopted the Phase 1 HCD Study and directed staff to proceed to Phase 2 of the Sharon HCD project in accordance with the proposed HCD boundaries illustrated in Appendix 1 of the Development Services Report DS2024-18.

A fourth public information session was hosted at the East Gwillimbury Civic

Centre on October 29, 2025 to obtain feedback on the draft Sharon HCD Plan.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Any person who attends the public meeting shall be given an opportunity to make oral representations with respect to the plan. A person who does not speak at this meeting or does not make written submission to Council before the by-law to adopt this Plan is made, may be denied an opportunity to appeal.

The next step is for the Town and consultant team to further refine the Sharon Heritage Conservation District Plan and by-law and prepare a presentation to the Town's Heritage Advisory Committee. Following this a report with recommendations, the HCD Plan, and adoption by-law will be brought to Council for consideration.
