Mount Albert Storm Outfalls and Trail Restoration Design Project

The Town of East Gwillimbury is hosting a Public Information Centre (PIC) for members of the public to learn about and provide feedback on the proposed design to restore storm sewer outfalls and a section of trail within Vivian Creek Park (please refer to map on the back of this page). This project will restore Town infrastructure and address ongoing erosion and slope stability concerns within those areas.

Aquafor Beech Limited has been retained by the Town to complete the design for this project. This work is currently in the design stage and construction is planned to begin in 2026, pending annual budget approvals later this year.
